	responsibility of the PRESENTER to ensure that the equipment requested in this rider is			
	available and functional and must be available to the artists for the setting up, sound and			
	lighting, concert, dismantling and (un)loading of all equipment.			
	One (1) technician is required for the installation of a projector, a screen and for the connection			
	of the computer and the projector for the surtitles.			
STAGE	The stage must be clean and free of all obstacles upon the artists' arrival.			
	WIDTH: 25' DEPTH: 30' HEIGHT: 12' (yard, garden and back)			
	One (1) black backdrop curtain.			
	Six (6) black pendants.			
	Two (2) friezes.			
	One (1) white cyclorama if available.			
	One (1) concert piano tuned on the day of the concert to A 440 Hz.
