# Assistant director and tour manager

As assistant director, you will participate in the creation of Jeunesses Musicales Canada's 2024 opera production, "La voix humaine & French melodies". #### **MAIN ROLES**

#### As assistant director

- Assist the stage director in the opera production "La voix humaine & French melodies" during rehearsals in Montreal and the production workshop in Quebec as part of the Festival d'Opéra de Québec;
- Provide a copy of the staging notebook to JM Canada before leaving on tour.

#### As tour manager

- Throughout the tour, ensure that the quality of the staging established during the production workshop is maintained. In theaters where the parameters differ from the "standard" scenes, adjust the staging if necessary while respecting the concept and guidelines of the original staging;
- Drive the vehicle rented by JM Canada with the technical director;
- Ensure the assembly and dismantling of sets and make adjustments of sets as necessary;
- Ensure that sets, costumes and props are in good condition. Wash costumes when necessary.

#### **REQUIREMENTS**

- You hold a relevant diploma in performing arts;
- You have experience in stage directing and stage management;
- You are bilingual: you are fluent in written and spoken French and English;

Salary to be discussed depending on training and experience.

Accommodation and per diems provided when you are outside your city of residence.

  - · Block 1 of the tour from September 20 to 25, 2024 (Abitibi)
  - · Block 2 of the tour from October 28 to November 18, 2024 (Eastern Quebec + NB)
