 - Composers: Scores in PDF format and accompanying recordings in MP3 and MP4 format. MIDI simulations are accepted when recordings are not available.
- A letter of recommendation from someone related to my artistic activities.

All material must be sent through a shareable and downloadable folder such as Dropbox or WeTransfer*, with the folder named as follows:
