

Laetitia-Cyr Scholarship

Through the Laetitia-Cyr Scholarship Fund, Jeunesses Musicales New Brunswick offers scholarships to New Brunswick instrumentalists and classical singers wishing to pursue advanced studies in classical music which may include taking master classes, attending a prominent music camp or participating in a national or international competition or a related music project.

Applications will be received between January 15 and April 15, 2021.

Applicants will receive a reply by May 15, 2021.

The Laetitia-Cyr Fund

The purpose of the Fund is to assist young emerging artists in classical music in New Brunswick. It further supports the various activities of JMNB in the promotion of classical music, especially among young people.

Eligible candidates

Any instrumentalist or classical singer pursuing advanced studies in classical music who is a resident of New Brunswick and less than 29 years of age on April 15, 2021.

Procedures for submitting a project

1. Use the registration form to submit the application for a scholarship.
2. The project must take place between April 16, 2021 and April 15, 2022.
3. Submit the description of the project by April 15, 2021.
4. Any application that is incomplete or non-compliant with the requirements of the registration form will be rejected.
5. A jury will evaluate the project and, if appropriate, decide the sum to be granted.
All decisions are final and without appeal.

Submit the following documents:

1. A complete and up-to-date curriculum vitae.
2. A letter describing your project and:
 - a. The name and address of the music camp you wish to attend; a proof of registration must be provided in order to receive the scholarship Proof can be provided after April 15, 2021.
 - b. If you are taking master classes, provide the name of the teacher(s) involved. A letter from the teacher or the institution is required as proof of your acceptance;
 - c. For a national or international competition, a letter describing the competition. A proof of acceptance must be submitted in order to receive the scholarship.
3. A photocopy of your Medicare card as proof of your residency in New Brunswick.
4. A budget specifying anticipated expenses (registration fees, accommodations, travel, etc.) and other sources of revenue.
