ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA 2022-2023

1. **CANDIDATE(S) SOUGHT**
All string students (violin or cello)
2. **APPLICATION DEADLINE**
March 10, 2023. 5 PM (ET)
3. **AGE**
28 years or less as of March 10, 2023
4. **REGISTRATION PROCEDURE**
Instrument bank registration is done through an authorized online form.

The artist must submit a complete file via the online form including the following elements

- Personal information
- Proof of age (driver's license, health insurance card, passport, etc.)
- A description of the instrument and bow you currently play
- Curriculum Vitae
- 150-word biography in both languages
- Artist's photo
- Letter of motivation
- Letter of recommendation from the student's instrument teacher
- A list of your current repertoire
- Two video recordings (YouTube link)

The repertoire submitted for selection shall include the following:

1. A work from the baroque or classical period
2. A work of your choice

All videos must be of high quality with excellent sound recording, filmed with a single fixed camera (no zooming or camera movement) and have been produced after July 1, 2022.

Videos must not be edited, enhanced or modified in any way. The work or movement must be performed in its entirety, either alone or accompanied by a pianist.

5. INSTRUMENT LOAN

The instruments are loaned for a period of 3 years.

Please note that the instrument must be delivered in person to the selected violinist and cellist at Jeunesses Musicales Canada's André Bourbeau House (located in Montreal). The recipient will be responsible for his or her own travel expenses as well as those of the instrument.

6. EVALUATION

- A pre-selection committee of three (3) members will evaluate the applications submitted.
- The committee will analyze the accepted applications and will choose, based on artistic excellence, the three (3) best candidates.
- If necessary, the three (3) finalists will be invited to perform in the Salle Joseph-Rouleau, located in the Maison André-Bourbeau at JM Canada. They will have to present the same repertoire as the one sent in the registration form.
